3. What wonderful words did Peter say to the lame man outside the Beautiful Gate of the Temple?
4. What important lesson do we learn from the story of Ananias and Sapphira?
5. The Jews could find no answer for Stephen's words. So how did they set out to trap him?
6. (a) Who is the man spoken of in Isaiah chapter 53?
(b) The Ethiopian eunuch believed what Philip taught him. What did he have to do then?
7. (a) Why did Saul journey to Damascus?
(b) Who spoke to Saul on the way to Damascus?
8. How was Peter able to heal Aeneas and Tabitha?
9. What did Cornelius do when Peter arrived at his house and what did Peter say?
10. What did the ecclesia do when Peter was put into prison?
11. How were Saul and Barnabas chosen to journey to distant places with the Gospel?
12. (a) At Antioch in Pisidia where did Paul and Barnabas go on the sabbath day?
(b) Who came to hear Paul speak on the next sabbath day at Antioch?
13. What was the name of an outstanding young disciple from Lystra who became Paul's close friend?
14. In Philippi what did the slave girl cry out about Paul and Silas?
15. In Philippi - What were Paul and Silas doing in prison about midnight?
16. (a) When Paul was in Athens - Where did the philosophers take Paul so that he could speak to them?
(b) What inscription did Paul notice on one of the altars in Athens?
17. When Paul first came to Corinth he stayed with two fellow Jews. Who were they?

23. On the way to Rome - In the midst of the storm what did Paul say would happen to the people on the ship?
24. On the island of Melita - What amazing thing happened to Paul as the people of Melita watched?

(b) What did Ananias do for Saul?
3. (a) What did the angel tell Cornelius to do?
(b) Peter saw a vision of a sheet filled with animals - What was God teaching Peter in this vision?
(c) What did Peter tell Cornelius about God?
4. Paul and Silas were in prison in Philippi -
(a) What happened at midnight in the jail at Philippi?
(b) When the jailor was about to kill himself, what did Paul cry out?
(c) What happened to the jailor and his household that night after the earthquake?
5. (a) As Paul was speaking about Christ's resurrection, what did Festus call out?
(b) What did Agrippa reply when Paul said to him, "I know thou believest the prophets"?
(c) When the meeting was over, what did Agrippa admit to Festus?
