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Please note:

- a) Division 11 or 12 include scholars who reach the age of 11 or 12 respectively on or before 31/12/02. (The year that Stage 1 lessons commenced).
- b) Scholars must record their division (ie. 11 or 12 - not both), age and allocated examination number on each sheet.
- c) Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.
- d) Leave a space between each answer. 2-3 lines.
- e) The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.

SECTION 'A' - 25 QUESTIONS: (2 marks each) Suggested time 40 minutes

Short answers only are required for the following 25 questions.

1. What is God's purpose with the earth?
2. What was the one commandment which God gave to Adam and Eve?
3. What did God do with Adam and Eve after they sinned?
4. When God saw so much wickedness on the earth, what two things did He tell Noah to do?
5. Who was the son promised to Abraham and Sarah and what does his name mean?
6. Where did Abraham send his servant to seek a wife for Isaac?
7. What was the sign Eliezer asked for to show him which was the right wife for Isaac?
8. What kind of man was Jacob?
9. What did Esau give away to Jacob in return for a bowl of food?
10. To whom did Joseph's brothers sell him and for how much?
11. How could Joseph interpret dreams?
12. What did the brothers find in their sacks when Joseph sent them home the first time?
13. What did Joseph say when he made himself known to his brethren?
14. How did Joseph's brothers feel when he told them who he was?

15. What strange sight did Moses see on Mt. Horeb?
16. Why did God send the plagues upon Egypt?
17. What was the terrible tenth plague to come upon Egypt?

19. How were the people given water at Rephidim?
20. What were the main divisions of the Tabernacle?
21. What was the Mercy Seat?
22. What was the Ark of the Covenant made of?
23. What were some of the duties of the priests?
24. What was written on the golden plate on the High Priest's forehead?
25. What were the names of the three most important feasts Israel had to keep?

3. What did Jacob see in his dream at Bethel?
4. What did the Lord Jesus Christ say were the two greatest commandments?

SECTION 'C' - 2 QUESTIONS (15 marks each) Suggested time 30 minutes

Essay type answers required.

*Select and answer **two questions only** from the following.*

1. In the beginning God created everything in heaven and on earth.
Tell all you know about the six days of creation.
2. Describe the promise God made to Abram as told in Genesis 12:1-3.
3. Tell the story of Pharaoh's cruel decree and how Moses was saved.
4. The people grew tired of waiting for Moses to return from Mt. Sinai.
(a) Tell the story of the golden calf.
(b) How did God punish the people for their wickedness?
