Please note:

- a) Divisions 13 or 14 include scholars who reach the age of 13 or 14 respectively on or before 31/12/02. (The year that Stage 1 lessons commenced).
- b) Scholars must record their division (ie.13 or 14 - not both), age and allocated examination number on each sheet.
- c) Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.
- d) Leave a space between each answer. 2-3 lines.
- e) The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.

SECTION 'A' - 8 QUESTIONS: (7 marks each) Suggested time 50 minutes

One paragraph only is required to answer each question in this section.

1. Briefly outline the events of the six days of creation.
2. Summarize what the two seeds of the promise in Eden represented.
3. What instruction do we find in the Bible about how to choose a marriage partner?
4. What did Joseph do when Potiphar's wife wanted to seduce him and why?
5. How can we be bearers of God's name?
6. List the ten plagues in order.
7. What are the lessons that arise from Israel's crossing of the Red Sea?
8. Name the three items of furniture that stood in the Holy Place. Briefly describe each one and say what it was used for.

SECTION 'B' - 2 QUESTIONS (22 marks each) Suggested time 40 minutes.

Essay type answers are required for these questions.

*Select and answer **two questions only** from the following.*

1. What does the Bible reveal to us about God?
2. What promises did God make to Abram when he called him to leave Haran. Briefly explain what the promises mean.
3. Explain how Jesus fulfilled the type of the Passover Lamb.
4. Explain the lessons that the Ten Commandments were designed to teach both Israel and ourselves.
