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SECTION 'A' - 25 QUESTIONS: (2 marks each) Approx. time 35 minutes.

We have learnt wonderful lessons this year about why God wrote the Bible, how God created the world and Adam and Eve, and many other wonderful stories. Could you please answer some questions about them for me, just short answers:-

1. What is God's purpose with the earth?
2. Who helped God when He set the earth in order?
3. What is sin?
4. What were the names of Adam and Eve's first two sons?
5. What sign did God give that He would never again destroy the earth with a flood?
6. When God called Abram to leave Ur where did God want him to go?
7. When Abram and Lot were separated, why was God pleased with Abram?
8. Who was the great "seed" through whom God would bless all the nations of the earth?
9. Whose help did the servant (Eliezer) ask so that he might choose a good partner for his master's son?
10. What did Esau give away to Jacob in return for a bowl of food?
11. What was Jacob's name changed to and what does it mean?
12. Jacob gave Joseph a special coat. What did Joseph's brothers think of this?
13. What did the brothers find in their sacks when Joseph sent them home the first time?
14. How did Joseph's brothers feel when he told them who he was?
15. What were the names of the father and mother of Moses?
16. At the burning bush what did the angel tell Moses God had chosen him to do?
17. How was Aaron's rod shown to be more powerful than the rods of the magicians?

18. What happened at midnight on the Passover night?
19. How were the people given water at Rephidim?
20. What did Jesus say was the first and greatest commandment?

22. Where was God's position in the camp of Israel?
23. Name the two pieces of furniture in the outer court of the Tabernacle.
24. Only one person could go into the Most Holy Place. Who was that?
25. What important time in the history of Israel was to be remembered by keeping the Passover Feast?

SECTION 'B' - 5 QUESTIONS: (6 marks each) Approx. time 30 minutes.

For these questions I would like a longer answer. Two or three sentences where necessary. Now could you please tell me a little more about:-

1. In the beginning God created everything in heaven and on earth. Tell all you know about the six days of creation.
2. (a) What covering did God provide for Adam and Eve?
(b) Who does this covering point forward to?
3. Tell the story of Pharaoh's two dreams and the real meaning that Joseph was able to explain to him.
4. Describe how the nation of Israel gained a victory over the Amalekites at Rephidim and what we learn from this lesson.
5. What did the Ark of the Covenant look like? What three things were inside it?

SECTION 'C' - 2 QUESTIONS: (10 marks each) Approx. time 25 minutes.

For the last two questions I would like you to please tell me about:

1. Describe the promise God made to Abram as told in Genesis 12:1-3.
2. Tell what you know of the plagues that God sent upon the land of Egypt. (Leave out the story of the last dreadful plague).
