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Please note:

- a) Divisions 13 or 14 include scholars who reach the age of 13 or 14 respectively on or before 31/12/03. (The year that Stage 2 lessons commenced).
- b) Scholars must record their division (ie.13 or 14 - not both), age and allocated examination number on each sheet.
- c) Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.
- d) Leave a space between each answer. 2-3 lines.
- e) The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.

➡ SECTION 'A' - 8 QUESTIONS: (7 marks each) Suggested time 50 minutes

One paragraph only is required to answer each question in this section.

1. What were the two great oaths Yahweh made when the report of the spies discouraged the people?
2. Explain how faith was demonstrated in the conquest of Jericho by
 - (1) Israel
 - (2) Rahab and her family
3. From Achan's confession show the step by step development of sin.
4. What was the cause of Israel's sufferings during the period of the Judges?
5. What lessons can we learn from Ruth's attitude to Naomi?
6. Finish the quote - "Hath Yahweh as great delight....". Briefly explain this verse.
7. What was the real issue of the contest between David and Goliath? Describe Goliath's challenge and explain David's words.
8. Why was Saul's visit to the witch of Endor wrong and hypocritical?

2. Describe how Israel was deceived by the Gibeonites. What lessons do we learn from the Gibeonites' deception and Israel's failure to consult Yahweh?
3. What lessons can you see for yourself in the story of Samson's life?
4. Explain the key points of the promise to David.
