7. Why were the soldiers of Israel beaten at Ai the first time?
8. After Joshua died, did the people continue to obey God?
9. An angel appeared to Gideon very suddenly.
 - (a) What did the angel say to him?
 - (b) Tell what happened when Gideon prepared a meal for the angel.
10. What did Gideon's men take with them for the battle?
11. What were the Philistines going to give Delilah if she found out why Samson was so strong?
12. What did Ruth do in the fields of Boaz?
13. When Samuel was old enough Hannah took him to Eli. What did she bring him each year?
