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Please note:

- a) Divisions 13 or 14 include scholars who reach the age of 13 or 14 respectively on or before 31/12/04. (The year that Stage 3 lessons commenced).
- b) Scholars must record their division (ie.13 or 14 - not both), age and allocated examination number on each sheet.
- c) Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.
- d) Leave a space between each answer. 2-3 lines.
- e) The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.

➡ SECTION 'A' - 8 QUESTIONS: (7 marks each) Suggested time 50 minutes

One paragraph only is required to answer each question in this section.

1. Using the incident of the two women and the baby, show the power of Solomon's God given wisdom.
2. Briefly describe the people's demand to Rehoboam at Shechem, and Rehoboam's response. How should we treat the advice of experienced brethren and sisters?
3. What did Elijah learn from the "still small voice"?
4. What is the parallel between the cleansing of Naaman and baptism?
5. How can we be like Josiah today?
6. Show how faith stopped the mouths of lions when Daniel disobeyed the king's decree?
7. Describe how Esther is a good role model for young women to follow.
8. What was the mission of John the Baptist?

➡ SECTION 'B' - 2 QUESTIONS (22 marks each) Suggested time 40 minutes.

Essay type answers are required for these questions.

Select and answer two questions only from the following.

1. Describe Solomon's temple and its furniture. Explain how the three divisions of the temple and their furnishings teach us how to approach to God.
2. Describe the contest between Elijah and the prophets of Baal; what lessons can we learn from this?
3. Describe fully Nebuchadnezzar's dream, how it was interpreted and what it means.
4. Describe the birth of Jesus and the joyful news the angels gave to the shepherds.
