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Please note:

- a) *Division 11 or 12 include scholars who reach the age of 11 or 12 respectively on or before 31/12/11. The year that Stage 5 lessons commenced.*
- b) *Scholars must record their division (ie.11 or 12 - not both), age and allocated examination number on each sheet.*
- c) *Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.*
- d) *Leave a space between each answer 2-3 lines.*
- e) *The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.*

➤ SECTION 'A' - 25 Questions: (2 marks each) Suggested time 40 minutes

Short answers only are required for the following 25 questions.

1. What was it that the apostles had hoped Jesus would do after his resurrection?
2. What is the gospel?
3. Which feast was held 50 days after the feast of Passover?
4. What wonderful words did Peter say to the lame man outside the Beautiful Gate of the Temple?
5. What important lesson do we learn from the story of Ananias and Sapphira?
6. What were Stephen's last words?
7. The Ethiopian eunuch believed what Philip taught him. What did he have to do then?
8. Who spoke to Saul on the way to Damascus?
9. What did Peter do before he raised Tabitha to life?
10. Peter saw a vision at Joppa - What was God teaching Peter in this vision?
11. What was Saul's name changed to?
12. Who gladly received the gospel in Antioch?
13. What was Paul's special message to the new ecclesias after he was stoned at Lystra?
14. In Philippi what did the slave girl cry out about Paul and Silas?

15. What inscription did Paul notice on one of the altars in Athens?
16. What wisdom must we treasure above all?

20. Why did Paul hurry back to Jerusalem at the end of his third journey?
21. When Festus wanted to send Paul back to the Sanhedrin in Jerusalem what did Paul say?

23. Who spoke to Paul to encourage him during the storm on the way to Rome?
24. What was the name of the island where Paul and those travelling to Rome with him were shipwrecked?

2. The lesson about Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch - This lesson teaches us the importance of baptism
 - (a) What is baptism?
 - (b) What must a person do after he is baptised?.
3. What did the Lord tell Ananias about Saul and the work he had been chosen to do?
4.
 - (a) What did the prophet Agabus do with Paul's girdle?
 - (b) What did Agabus tell Paul?

➡ SECTION 'C' - 2 Questions (15 marks each) Suggested time 30 minutes

1. Tell how Peter was imprisoned by Herod and miraculously set free.
2. Tell what happened when Saul and Barnabas preached the Gospel on the island of Cyprus.
