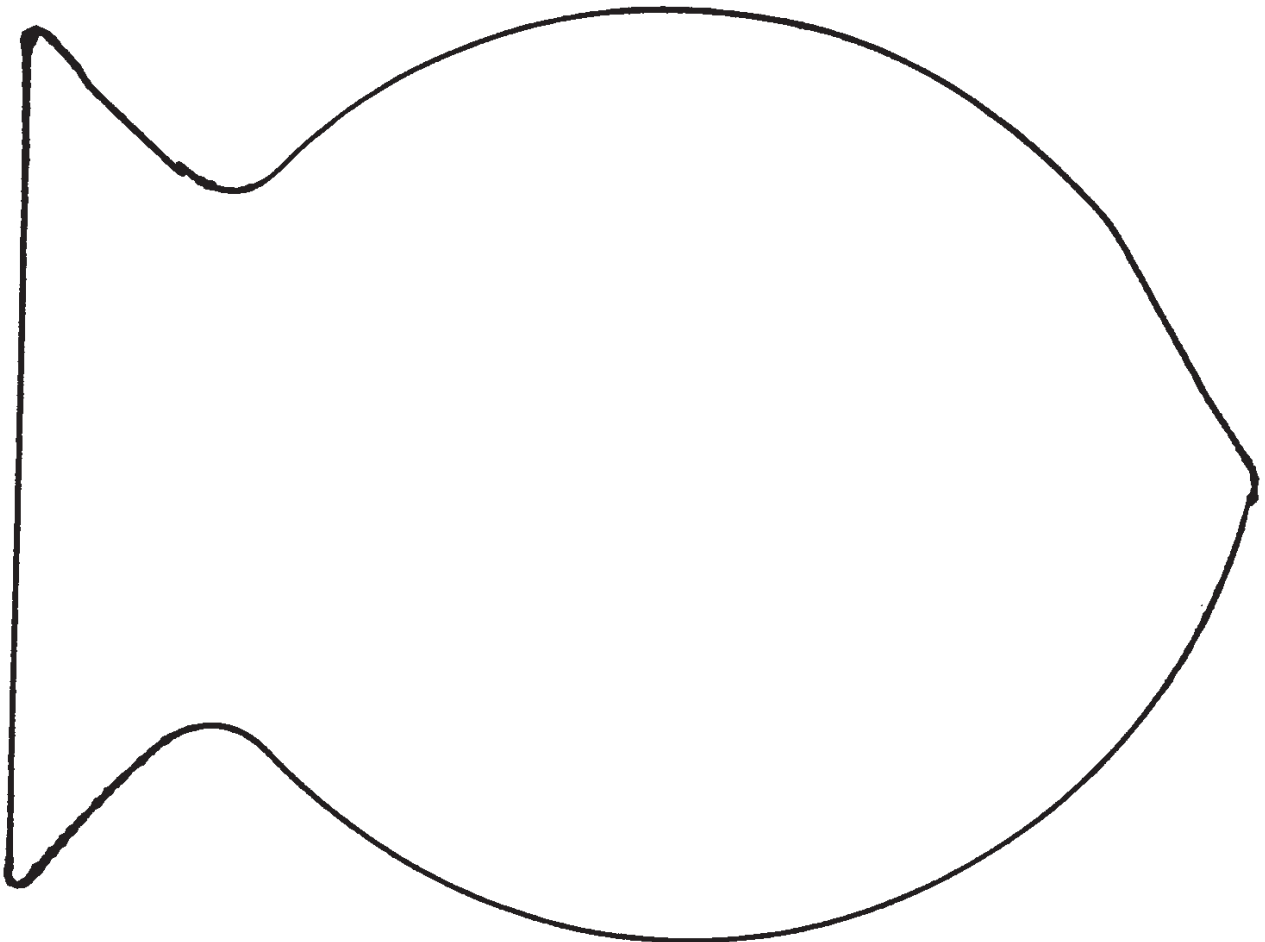

wiggly eye

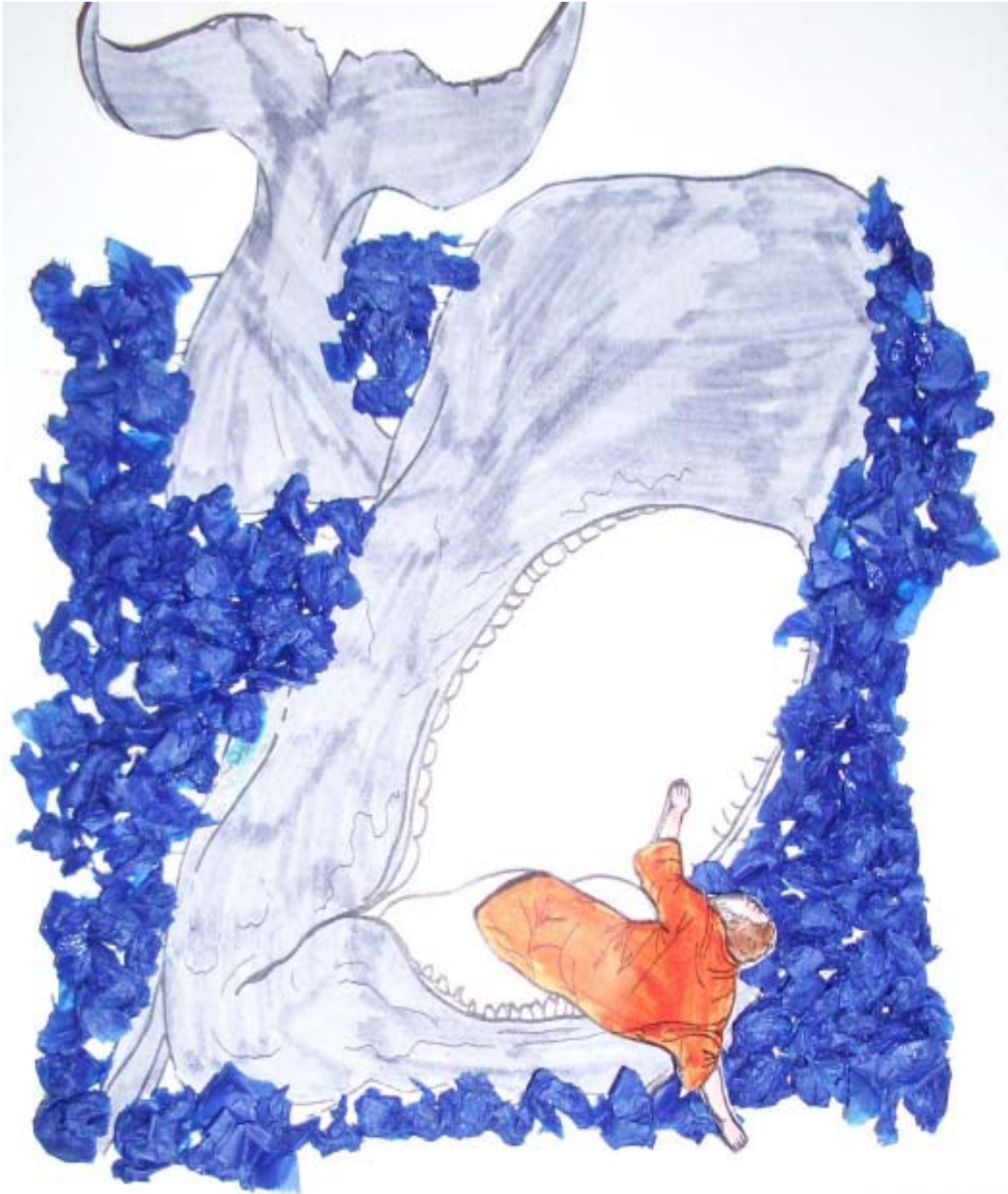
cut out template

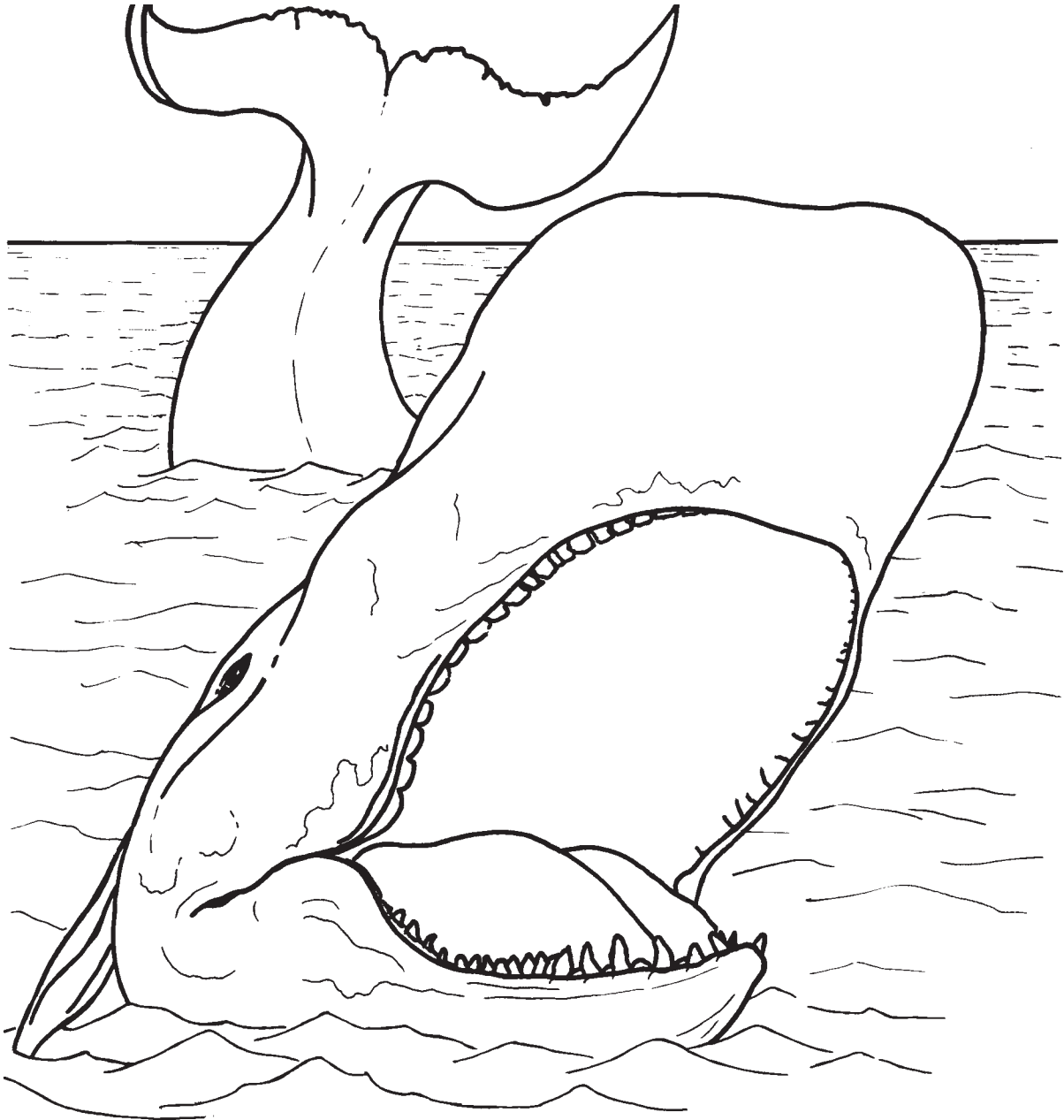

stapler

and blow him out**

Steps

cut out fin
stick tail and lips on
decorate
paste Jonah under fin

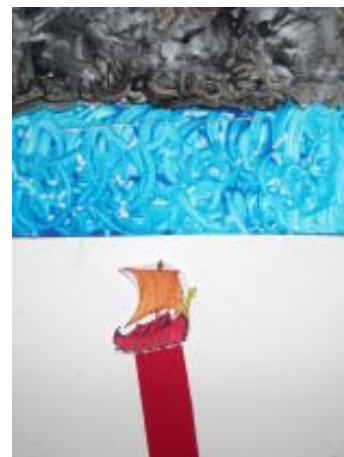


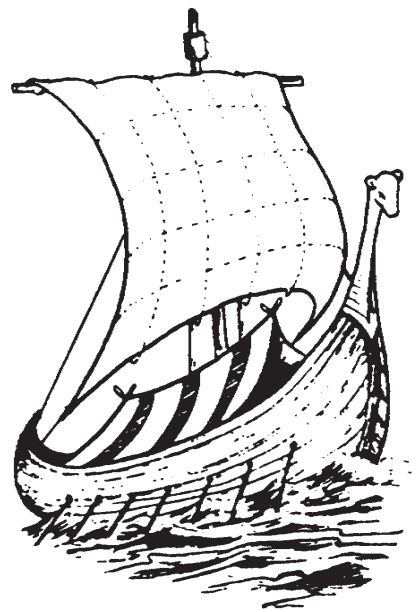
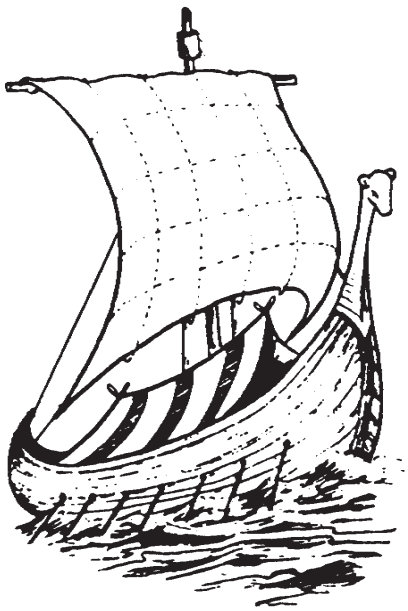
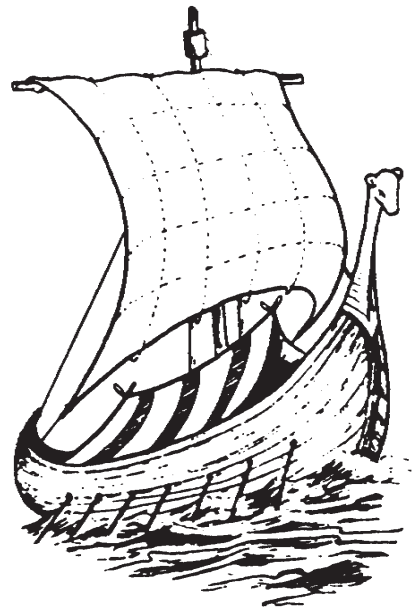
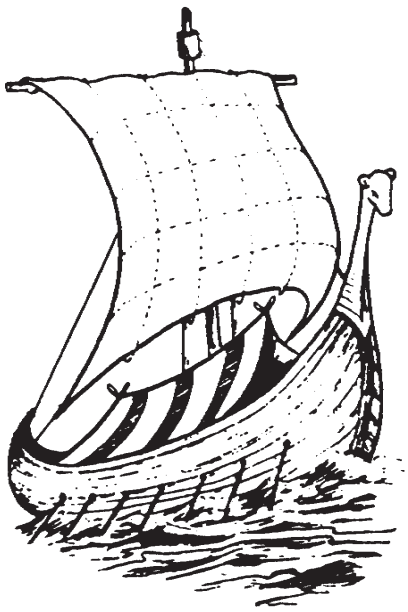
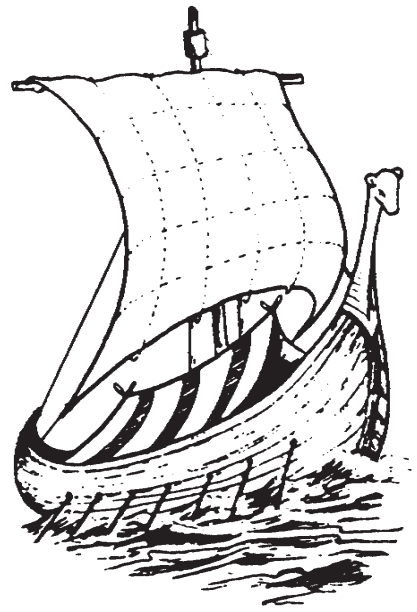
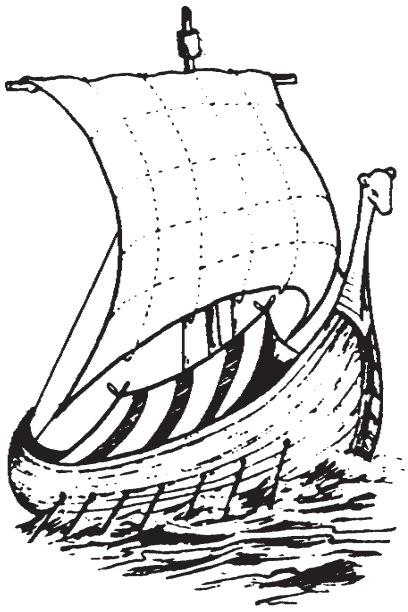
Materials

cut a line so the boat can move along

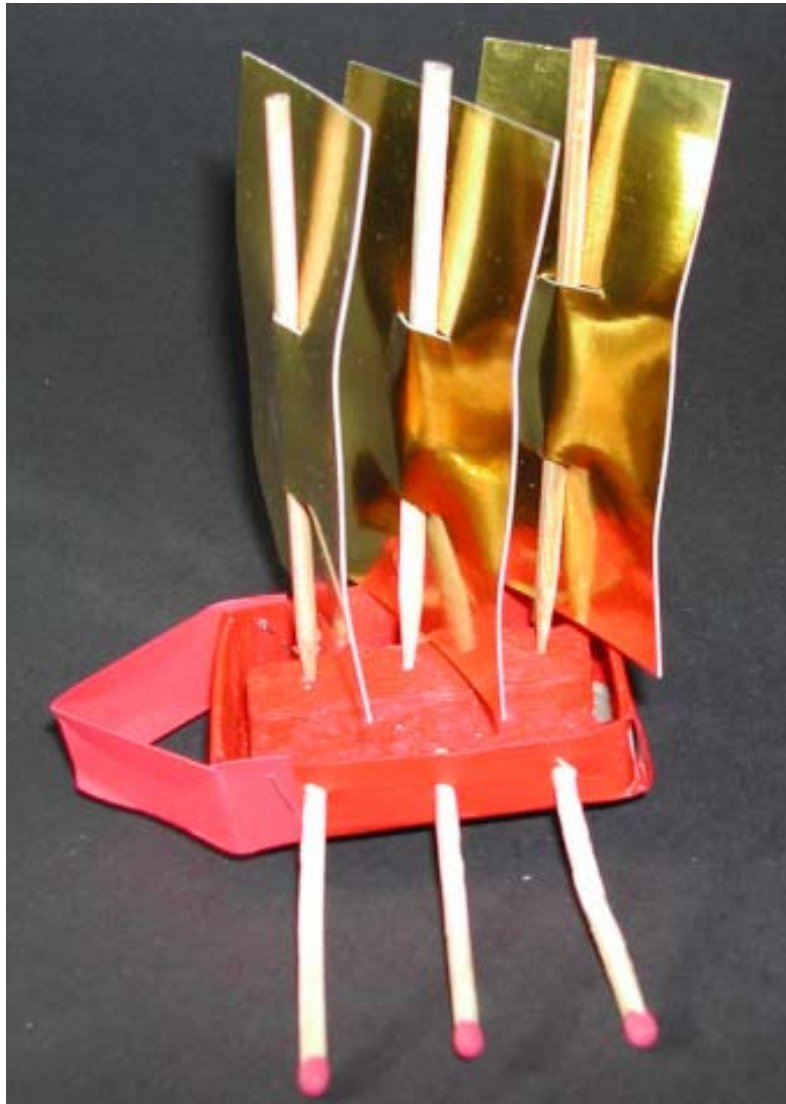

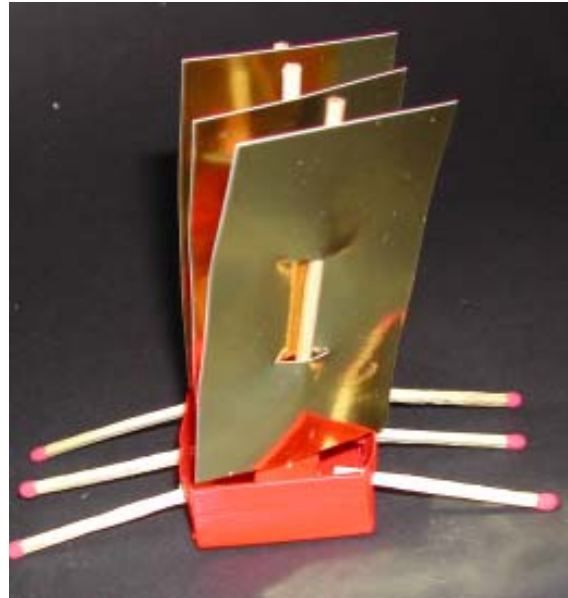

Materials

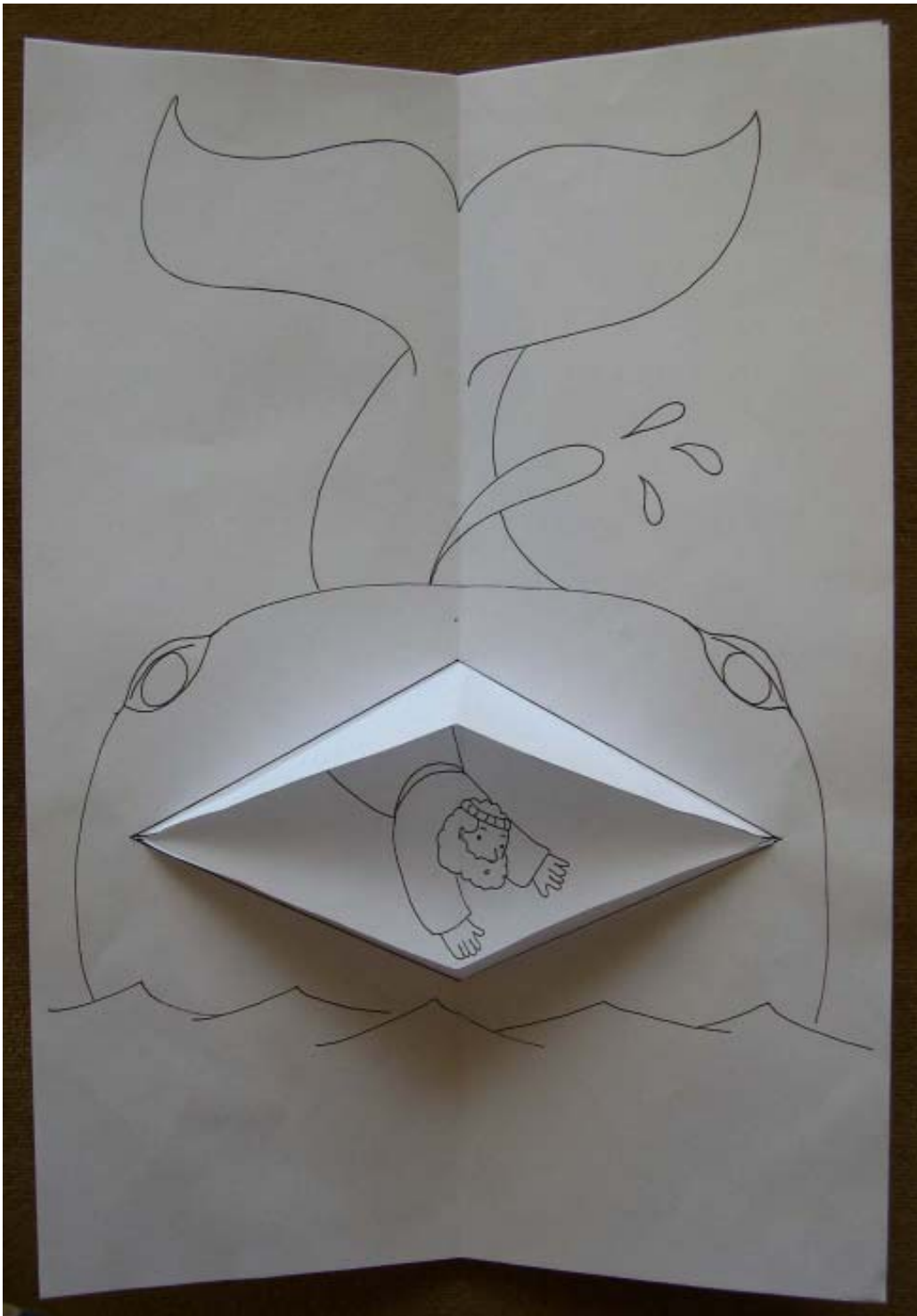
gold cardboard

Primary Stage 3 Lesson 12 - H Jonah in the fish

Materials

2 pieces of A4 paper with the templates printed on them
glue
scissors
coloured pencils

Steps

1. Fold the big fish piece of paper in half vertically
2. Find the centre of the mouth and cut open
3. Fold back the flaps to form a top and bottom triangle
4. Open up the triangles, turn the page up and adjust the mouth so it will open
5. Glue both sheets of paper together, but don't glue the mouth down!
