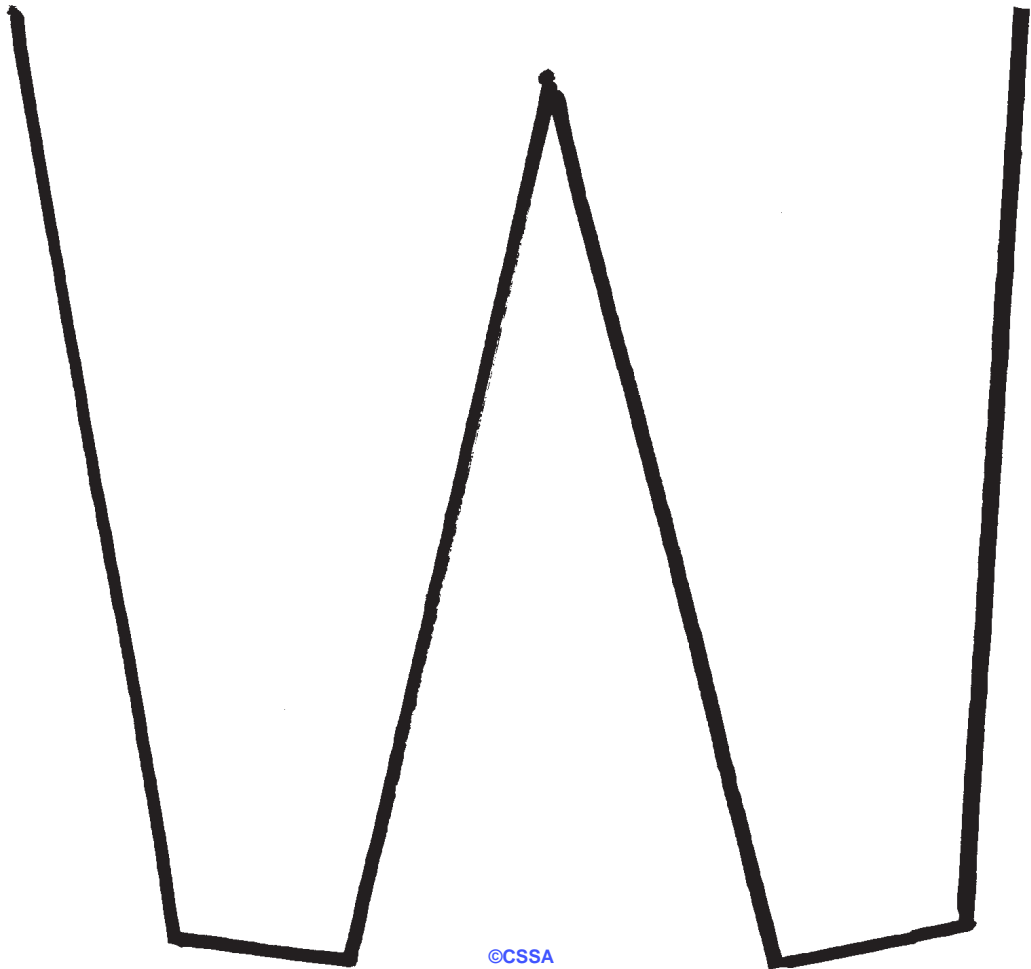
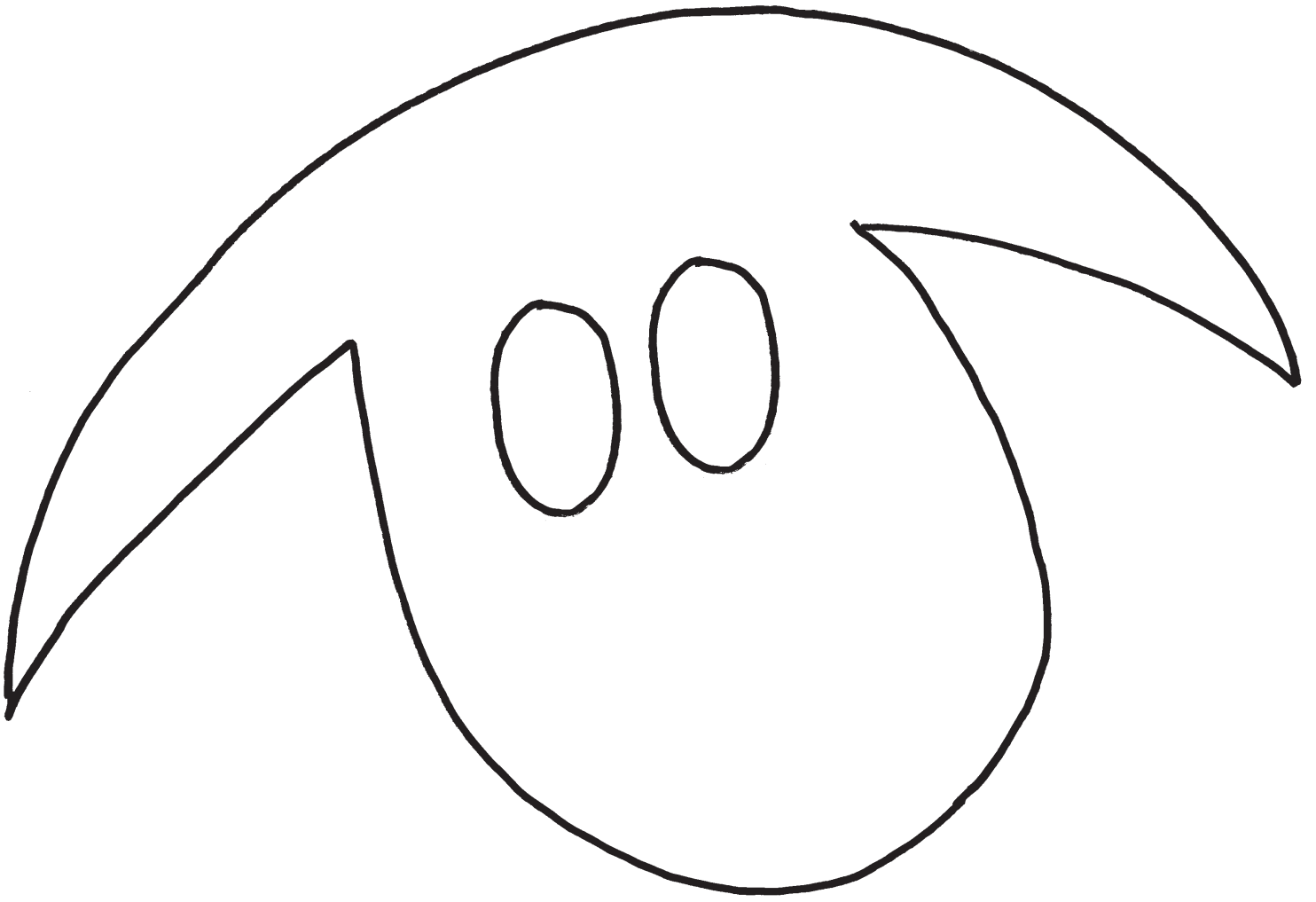
- wadding
