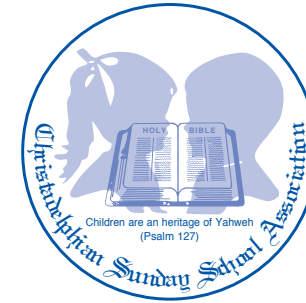


Junior Activity Worksheets Stage 5

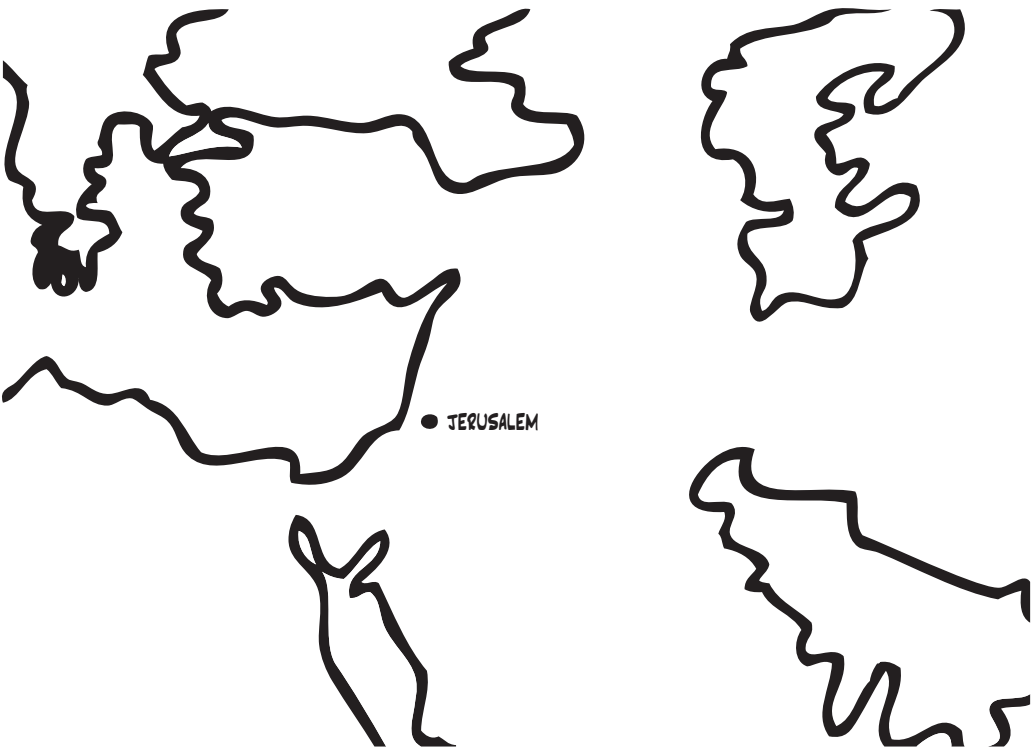

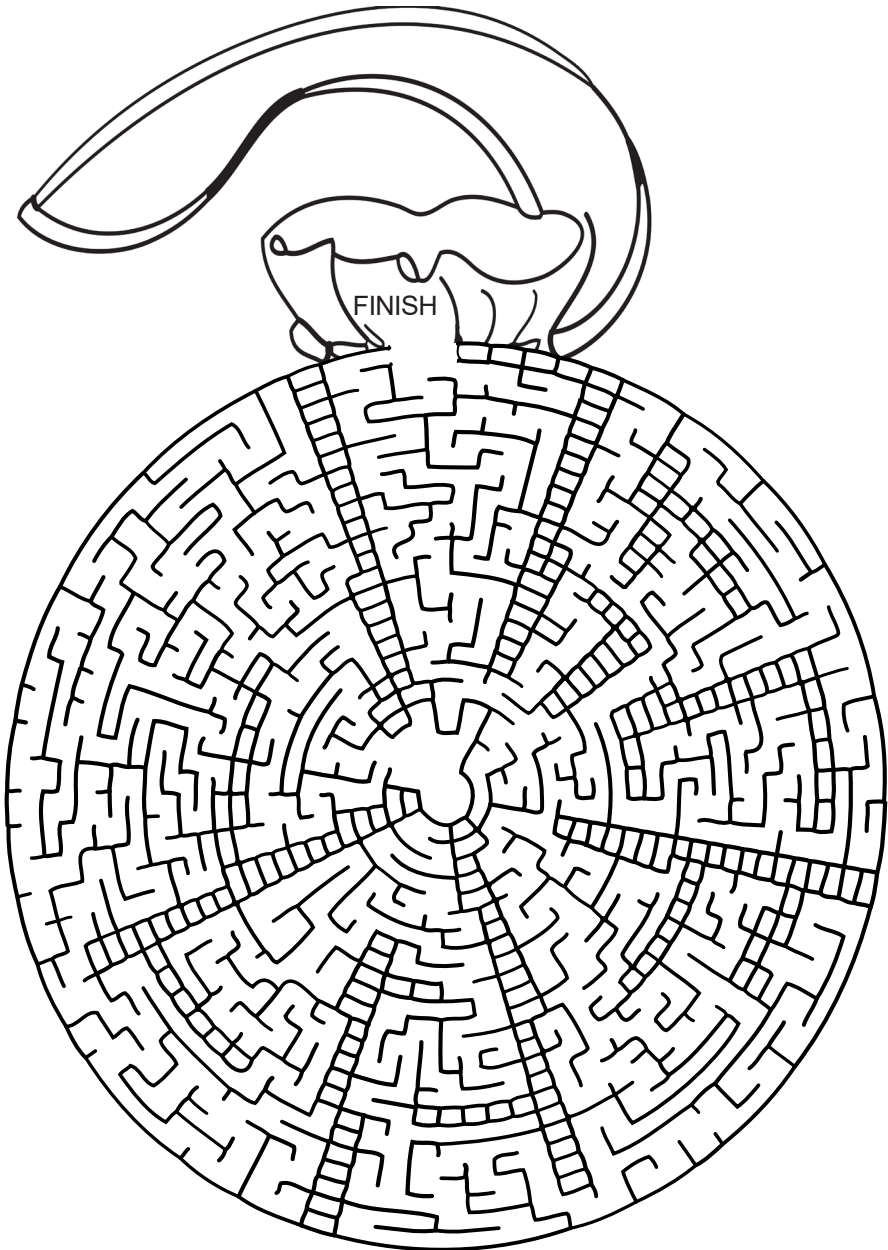
