Please note:

- a) *Division 11 or 12 include scholars who reach the age of 11 or 12 respectively on or before 31/12/10. The year that Stage 4 lessons commenced.*

- c) *Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.*
- d) *Leave a space between each answer 2-3 lines.*
- e) *The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.*

**SECTION 'A' - 25 Questions: (2 marks each) Suggested time 40 minutes**

***Short answers only are required for the following 25 questions.***

1. Who was John the Baptist preparing the way for?
2. When Jesus asked John to baptise him, what did John say?
3. *In the wilderness* what did the tempter want Jesus to prove?
4. Four disciples were fisherman. What did Jesus say they would catch from now on?
5. What does the word "disciple" mean?
6. What was Jesus talking about when he said we must be "born of water"?
7. Why did the nobleman come to Cana looking for Jesus?
8. Why were the people in the synagogue at Nazareth surprised when they heard Jesus speak?
9. When Jesus healed people, who did he want the people to praise?
10. When will disciples of Christ receive their reward for being faithful?
11. What most important thing does Jesus tell us we must seek first?
12. Why should we pray, "Give us this day our daily bread"?
13. Jesus was the sower in the parable. What is the seed?

***Essay type answers required.***

***Select and answer two questions only from the following.***

1. Tell the story of Jesus' first miracle at Cana.
2. A lawyer asked Jesus, "Who is my neighbour?" Tell the parable Jesus told in answer to the question.
3. Tell the parable of the Ten Virgins. *Don't forget to mention*
  - (a) Who is the "bridegroom"?
  - (b) Who are the "virgins"?
  - (c) What warning did Jesus give his disciples when he finished telling this parable?
4.
  - (a) Tell what happened on the mount of Olives, when Jesus was with his disciples for the last time.
  - (b) Why is it so important for us to remember what the angels said?
