5. Who was angry when Jesus said to the man, "Thy sins be forgiven thee"?
6. Why were some of the Jews angry about the miracle at the pool of Bethesda?
7. What did the people in the crowds say after Jesus had raised the dead man at Nain?
8. What will happen to the dead people who have loved and obeyed God when Jesus comes back to earth to set up God's kingdom?
9. After preaching to the people, Jesus and his disciples went in a boat across the Sea of Galilee. As Jesus slept, what happened?
10. What did the disciples think of Jesus when he stilled the storm on the Sea of Galilee?
11. When Jesus explained the parable of the Sower what did he say the seed was?
12. In the parable of the Sower why should we try to be like the good ground?
13. Why was Jairus sad when he came to Jesus?
14. After Jesus had finished preaching to the 5,000 people, he prayed to God and blessed the food. What did the disciples do then?
15. (a) What happened when Peter tried to walk on the water to Jesus?
(b) Why did Peter begin to sink into the water?
