5. What was Jesus talking about when he said we must be "born of water"?
6. When will we be "born of the spirit"?
7. What words did Jesus say to the nobleman from Capernaum that made him happy?
8. Why were the people in the synagogue at Nazareth surprised when they heard Jesus speak?
9. How was the way Jesus taught different from the scribes?
10. What most important thing does Jesus tell us we must seek first?
11. God knows what we need before we ask, so why should we pray?
12. (a) The disciples found one person in the crowd of 5000 with some food. What did he have?
(b) After the miracle of feeding 5000 what did the people want to do to Jesus?
13. How many people came by and saw the wounded man lying by the road? Who were they?
14. Where did Jesus send the blind man to wash?
15. How do the sheep know which shepherd to follow?
16. *In the story of the prodigal son* what words did the father say to show why they should have a feast?
17. Lazarus was dead. What did Martha and Mary each say to Jesus when they met him?
18. What did Jesus say when he drove the traders out of the temple the second time?
19. (a) In the parable of the ten virgins, what cry went out at midnight?
(b) In the parable of the talents, what did the lord of the household expect the servants to do with what

 - (c) Why did Jesus tell us to pray, "Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors"?
