## PRIMARY INSTRUCTIONS STAGE 2 (4–6 years)

### PARENTS PLEASE REMEMBER:

- Your children look for and need your support, encouragement, and ideas when working on their projects, but the actual work on each page must be the child's own work.
- Please read the booklet 'GUIDELINES TO GOOD PROJECTS', available for download from <https://cssa.asn.au/downloads/booklets>.
- Remember that the layout and size of the pictures on each page must not be altered, to ensure fairness in marking.
- The activities have been printed on one side of the page for ease of completion. The activity must be completed on this side only. Any extra information placed on the back of the page won't be considered for marking.
- Do not write your name anywhere on the project.
- Hand the project in to your Sunday School Superintendent by the due date, **28th JULY 2023**.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- "Show" means you may choose to draw, paint, glue, use collage or any other technique to illustrate the subject. Some ideas: pipe cleaners, red ribbon, sandpaper, silver foil, fabric, etc.
- "Colour" means you may use pencil, paint, crayon, texta or glued on colour or decorations to make your picture attractive.
- "Write" means you may write with pencil, biro, texta etc, or you may use any other way to tell your answer in words.

#### Page 1. Title Page

Colour in the page, including the heading, as neatly as you can. Show some more sheep next to David.

You might like to use cotton wool.....

#### Page 2. The 12 Spies (Lesson 2)

When the spies went into the Promised Land they found a cluster of grapes so big that it took two men to carry it.

1. Make a large bunch of grapes hanging from their pole - you might like to use coloured paper cut out and glued on, or you might like to draw them.....
2. Colour the two spies and finish the picture as you like.....

#### Page 3. Fiery Serpents (Lesson 5)

God sent a terrible plague of fiery serpents upon the Israelites. God told Moses to make a brass serpent on a pole, and when the people looked at the serpent they didn't die.

1. Show a brass serpent on a pole as Moses was instructed by God to make.....
2. Colour in the rest of the page, including the heading. You may like to add people, snakes or tents to the picture.....

#### Page 4. The Fall of Jericho (Lesson 9)

Here is Rahab's house. It is all that is left standing of the walls of Jericho.

1. Colour in the heading and Rahab's house.....
2. Show Rahab at the window and the scarlet cord she hung out for the Israelites to see. ....
3. Show some of the stones on Rahab's house and also some stones scattered around the edges and along the bottom of the page to show what happened to the rest of the wall of Jericho. You might like to use sandpaper or brown felt.....

**Page 5. Achan** (Lesson 10)

Here is Achan in his tent hiding the items he had stolen from Jericho.

1. Show Achan's tent. You will find Achan's tent door on the cut-out page. Decorate it and then cut it out. Fold the tent door along the dotted line, then put some glue on the tab and fix it onto the page in the box provided, so the tent door can open.....
2. Inside the tent show the treasure that Achan stole from Jericho. You may use the items on the cut-out page, or make your own.....
3. Colour in the rest of the page, including the heading.....

**Page 6. Gideon** (Lesson 13)

On this page we are illustrating the victory of Gideon over the Midianites.

1. Colour the heading.....
2. Show in the correct boxes the items that Gideon's men carried. You can use the pictures of the items on the cut-out page, or you can make your own.....
3. Finish the quote at the bottom of the page by writing in the number of men that lapped the water. ....

**Page 7. Ruth** (Lesson 15)

On this page we are illustrating Ruth the Moabitess gleaning in the fields of Boaz.

1. Colour the heading.....
2. Colour or decorate the picture of the field where Ruth went to glean .....
3. You will find a picture of Ruth on the cut-out page. Colour her in and glue her over the picture of the field, either as a flap so she stands up, or flat on the page.....

**Page 8. Samuel** (Lesson 17)

On this page we are illustrating the boy Samuel serving in the tabernacle of God.

1. Samuel's mother made a coat for him to wear in the tabernacle. Decorate the coat on the cut-out page, carefully cut it out and glue it on the picture of the little boy.....
2. Trace over the letters to find out what Eli told Samuel to say when God called him in the night.....
3. Colour the heading.....

**Cover**

When you have completed the inside of your project, cover the project and decorate it. You could write some words which give a title to the project. It may be "The Establishment of the Kingdom" or a suitable quote. You might even add a picture about the lessons on the front. To protect your project you could cover it with plastic or contact. Do not write your name anywhere on the project .....

**When you have finished your project, check to make sure you have completed all the instructions (use the check boxes) and then remove cut-out pages and instructions from your project.**
