## PRIMARY PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS — STAGE 3 (7–8 Years)

### PARENTS PLEASE REMEMBER:

- Your children look for and need your support, encouragement, and ideas when working on their projects, but the actual work on each page must be the child's own work.
- Remember that the layout and size of pictures on each page must not be altered, to ensure fairness in marking.
- The activities have been printed on one side of the page for ease of completion. The activity must be completed on this side only. Any extra information placed on the back of the page won't be considered for marking.
- All quotes have been referenced from the King James Version of the Bible. Please use this version to answer the missing words from the quotes in the activities.
- Do not write your name anywhere on the project.
- Hand the project in to your Sunday School Superintendent by the due date, **27<sup>th</sup> JULY 2025**.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- "Show" means you may choose to draw, paint, glue, use collage or any other technique to illustrate the subject.
- "Colour" means you may use pencil, paint, crayon, texta, or glued on colour or decorations to make your picture attractive.
- "Write" means you may write with pencil, biro, texta etc, or you may use any other way to tell your answer in words.

### Page 1. Contents Page

Colour the contents page and make it look like a very old scroll. You could rub black and brown pencil shavings into the scroll to give it an old look .....

### Page 2. Solomon – Lesson 2 & 3

1. When Solomon first became king, God spoke to him in a dream by night. Fill in the blanks to find out what was said, using 1 Kings 3:5 and 9 or see your lesson book. Colour the picture of Solomon having the dream.....
2. Write what Solomon built for God on the dotted line next to the picture, using these scrambled letters as a clue: E P L E T M. Colour the picture of this special building. The Bible tells us that the pillars were made of brass and the folding doors were covered in gold. ....

### Page 3. Elijah – Lesson 6

- On Mt Carmel Elijah made an altar from 12 stones, to make a sacrifice to God.
1. Complete the picture of Elijah's sacrifice. You could use cellophane for flames, sandpaper for stones, toothpicks for wood and glitter for water . ....
  2. Show Elijah at the side of the altar.....
  3. Fill in the missing words to tell what happened to Elijah's sacrifice. Look up 1 Kings 18:38 or see your lesson book .....

**Page 4. Naaman – Lesson 11**

1. Join the dots to complete the picture of Naaman obeying Elisha's command. ....
2. Colour the rest of the page. You could glue on small leaves from a bush to use as leaves for the tree.....
3. In the space at the side of the page write the number that tells us how many times Naaman had to wash in the water to be clean from his leprosy.....
4. Fill in the missing words which tell what Naaman did.....

**Page 5. Nebuchadnezzar's Dream – Lesson 16**

1. Colour the picture of Nebuchadnezzar having his dream.....
2. Colour Nebuchadnezzar's dream, showing the colour of the metals which made up the image .....
3. At the bottom of the page complete the quote from Daniel 2:44 .....

**Page 6. Fiery Furnace – Lesson 17**

Daniel's friends were thrown into a fiery furnace when they refused to bow down and worship Nebuchadnezzar's image.

1. Show the right number of men that Nebuchadnezzar saw walking inside the furnace .....
2. Colour the furnace. It was made 7 times hotter, so make it look very hot! You could use cellophane for flames and cotton wool for smoke. ....
3. Look up Daniel 3:17, and fill in the missing words which show the faith and trust of Daniel's friends .....

**Page 7. Queen Esther – Lesson 19 & 20**

God was with Esther, and the king loved her the most and chose her to be the queen.

1. Colour Queen Esther on the cut-out page and make her look lovely .....
2. Cut Queen Esther out and glue her on the page in front of the king. ....
3. Colour the page and make a crown for King Ahasuerus. You will find in Esther 1:6 and your lesson notes (Lesson 19) what colours were used to decorate the king's palace

**Page 8. Messiah is Born – Lesson 23**

1. Jesus was born in a manger in Bethlehem. Colour the pictures of baby Jesus and Mary on the cut-out page and use them to recreate the stable scene .....
2. Use some of the animals on the cut-out page or draw your own to add to the scene.
3. Colour the rest of the picture.....
4. Write what the name Jesus means in the space provided .....

**Cover** When you have completed the inside of your project, cover the project and decorate it. You could write some words which give a title to the project. It may be "The Glory and Decline of the Kingdom" or a suitable quote. You might even add a picture about the lessons on the front. To protect your project you could cover it with plastic or contact.
